

Consequences of Underage Drinking Citation

- Loss of Driver's License for 90 days for the first offense and one or two years for subsequent offense(s), regardless of whether or not the minor was driving.
- Fines for
 - Legal costs for attorneys and expungement
 - Denial of college admission/loss of scholarships
 - Negative impact on job applications

Teens can get in serious legal trouble.

Not just for underage drinking, but also for:

- Lying about age to gain access to alcohol, including making, selling or even a fake ID;
- Buying or even trying to buy alcohol when under 21;
- Asking or hiring someone over 21 to purchase alcohol;
- Adults can be held responsible for giving alcohol to a minor.
